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About the ETN

The UBS Certificate on the MSCI World ESG Leaders Index is designed to replicate the index by holding all constituents in the exact index weighting. The index is rebalanced quarterly and therefore incurs minimal trading fees.

About the index

The MSCI World ESG Leaders Index is a capitalization weighted index that provides exposure to companies with high Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) performance relative to their sector peers. MSCI World ESG Leaders Index is constructed by aggregating the following regional Index MSCI Pacific ESG Leaders Index, MSCI Europe & Middle East ESG Leaders Index, MSCI Canada ESG Leaders Index and MSCI USA ESG Leaders Index. The parent index is MSCI World Index, which consists of large and mid-cap companies in 23 Developed Markets Countries.

Opportunities

- Gives investors exposure to top holdings worldwide that have excelled in meeting ESG criteria. These companies demonstrate competence in business sustainability and are more geared towards long-term value creation.
- Diversification across top ESG holdings from different industries in various countries, with quarterly rebalancing and annual reconstitution.
- Objective-focused and transparent index design: index components are selected by MSCI, the index provider.
- Tradable every trading day under normal trading conditions.

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Risks
